2. Other Portable Transponder Issues

- a. P. Smith has written to the BOG an appeal of the committee's decision to deny his portable transponder application. - c. Bob Sutherland requested that Brittany Harrington obtain the following information from portable transponder applicants:
  - 1) Do they keep a non-rental vehicle here in Gateway
  - 2) Clarify the number of portable transponders being requested
  - 3) Clarify they understand there is a \$50.00 charge for each portable transponder.
